Introduction


The installation should be carried out by a competent person, in compliance with general and locally applicable regulations.

Replacing the control consists out of several steps, such as:


- Isolating the water heater;
- Replacing the control;
- Activating the new control;
- Commissioning the water heater.

Isolate the water heater

- 1. Isolate the water heater from the main power supply (see Installation, User, Service and Maintenance Instructions <u>10.3 "Electrically isolating the water heater"</u>).
- 2. Shut of the gas supply.
- 3. Undo the screws of the plastic covers.



4. Carefully remove the covers from the top of the water heater




Replace the control

1. Carefully loosen the cables at the rear of the control.

REMARK

Also pull the dummy out of the control and leave the selection resistance in the cable harness.


2. Remove the control from the water heater by loosening the four bolts on both sides of the control.



- 3. Mount the new control onto the water heater using the four bolts.
- 4. Insert the cables and the dummy into the control again (see table and picture).

Commissioning the water heater

- 1. Replace the covers.
- 2. Open the manual gas control valve.
- 3. Switch on the main power to the appliance using the isolator between the appliance and the power supply.
- Switch the controller on ON by setting the ON/OFF switch to position I. The display will now show INTERNAL CHECK for about 10 seconds, and will then go to the main menu.



5. When activating the OFF, ON, WEEKPROGRAM or EXTRA PERIOD a C04 error (selection error) message appears on the display.

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- 6. Adjust the appliance selection in the control. Call up the select appliance menu via:

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
